### COMPLETE STREETS IMPLEMENTATION GRANT APPLICATION

#### **OVERVIEW**

Southwest Region Planning Commission (SWRPC) and the Monadnock Alliance for Sustainable Transportation (MAST) invite interested municipalities in the Southwest Region of New Hampshire to apply for funding, up to \$10,000, for a Complete Streets implementation project. Projects must be completed by November 1, 2017. In order to apply, municipalities must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Municipality has adopted a Complete Streets policy;
- 2. The legislative body (Select Board, City Council, or authorized representative of the legislative body) supports the proposed project and certifies project will be implemented before November 1, 2017 (see Attachment A for template letter);
- 3. The project has the approval of the landowner or right-of-way owner (including NHDOT) associated with the project area, if applicable; and
- 4. The project application is complete.
