

Town of Harrisville Pop-Up Complete Streets Demonstration



The Town of Harrisville, in partnership with Southwest Region Planning Commission (SWRPC), is planning a temporary pop-up Complete Streets demonstration in the Harrisville Village Center to showcase how safety and pedestrian access can be improved on Main Street.

Complete Streets are streets that are safe, convenient, and accessible to a wide variety of users and transportation modes. The pop-up demonstration will take place on Saturday, July 8th during Old Home Day Weekend and will include two temporary crosswalks marked with removable tape (see map) and signs to alert motorists of the pedestrian crossings as they near them. SWRPC will also set up comment boxes for residents to provide feedback on the roadway changes. The goal of the event is to engage residents in future planning efforts and to initiate conversations about how to make Harrisville's streets safer, more convenient, and accessible to a wide variety of users and transportation modes.
